Signs of Spring!

It's been an exciting few weeks here on the farm. Despite the blanket of snow and icy cold outside, signs of spring are emerging. The days are getting longer and brighter, birdsong is again filling the air, and the seed catalogs are piling up. ☺ We have big plans for the summer of 2021 and are delighted to invite our community to share in them!

At our February working party, we started seeds indoors for our cold-tolerant plants: kale, swiss chard, arugula, spinach and fennel. To our amazement, the seedlings sprouted just three days later, helped by humidity domes, warming mats under the seed trays, and a combination of shop lights and LEDs that transmitted just the right combination of pink and blue rays, to promote growth and photosynthesis.


